

PACKAGING FEES

On the 1st of January 2024, the municipalities took over the responsibility for collection of household packaging from TMR. Now, TMR will receive, sort and recycle packaging collected by the municipalities. The municipalities will receive compensation from TMR for collection according to Naturvårdsverket's (Swedish Environmental Protection Agency) regulations. TMR continues to be responsible for collection and recycling of the businesses' packaging.

The packaging fee is the fee that the producer pays to TMR for collection, sorting and handling of end-of-life packaging. The packaging fee is calculated per material type and charged as a cost per kilograms of packaging material. Excess payment, if any, will be refunded.

Packaging fees for paper och plastic are categorized according to the recyclability of the packaging material. The easier it is to recycle the packaging material, the lower the packaging fee. Plastic include three categories of recyclability and paper two categories.

TMR shall bill the client packaging fees on a quarterly basis in arrears, based on the received reports. The minimum debit per quarter is SEK 1 000.
